




Pathways to adoption







Meeting the material information needs of stakeholders focused on impacts, aligned with a broader materiality approach, reporting against both the ISSB and the GRI standards.




TNFD Adopters as of COP16 (Oct 2024)













Adopters by region





Addressing nature-related data challenges


- 1. Provide long-term funding to address coverage and quality gaps;

Data roadmap: Approach, timeline and milestones






